Recognizing family needs for flexibility in their children's education and that the traditional school setting and program may not be the best "fit" for all children and families,

Western Placer Unified School District is expanding its programs in the 2012/2013 school year to include a full-time alternative to students and their families:

The Independent Study Scholar Academy

Through the Independent Study Scholar Academy, students will meet individually or in small groups of up to four students with their Independent Study Teacher for a minimum of two hours per week. During that time, the teacher will review assignments that have been assigned and completed during the previous week, answer questions, present new lessons, make new assignments. Students will be expected to work independently and with family support to complete the assignments as given.

Key Program Components:

- Focus on Common Core State Standards (CCSS)
 - Flexible Hours with Individualized Attention
 - Weekly Group Help Sessions
- Eligibility for Inclusion in Regular Specialized Programs (Activities, Electives, Athletics, ROP ~ if meet criteria)
- Available Option to Students on IEP's if Recommended Through IEP Process
