**Students must provide proof of a negative test prior to departure. Participants cannot get on the bus/transportation if they are exhibiting any COVID symptoms.** Regardless of vaccination status, all students and chaperones must provide proof of a negative antigen or PCR test result (with student's name, date of testing, and results clearly shown) prior to departure. The sample must have been taken and read within 48 hours of the planned departure. For this field trip, the test must be taken and results received between

**Travel by bus:** students and chaperones will be traveling on a district or charter bus or personal vehicle. Students and chaperones will be as socially distanced as possible on the bus and will be expected to wear their masks at all times over their nose and mouth while on the bus. Students and chaperones seats will be notated on a seating chart, and students and chaperones will sit in the same assigned seat on the way there and back. We will attempt to maximize air flow on the bus by having the AC run and/or the windows open. Students and chaperones will be told specific times when they can eat during the trip as determined by the teacher/school staff.

**Risk of contact:** if a student or chaperone does become ill while on the trip, it is possible that the entire group will be identified as a close contact. Depending on the circumstances, parents of impacted students may have to sign an attestation (agreement to get a COVID test two times over the 10 day modified quarantine period) to return to school in person, or could be told to quarantine at home for a period of time after the trip if a student were to become positive on the trip or shortly after the trip.

**If a student becomes ill while on the trip:** the parent/guardian of the ill student would be contacted and the parent/guardian would need to travel to the field trip location to pick up the student. The student will be quarantined until the parent/guardian arrives.

**Sleeping arrangements:** students and chaperones will be sleeping with a maximum of two per room. Students must remain masked while in their room at all times unless they are alone (in the room or in the restroom), actively sleeping, actively eating or actively drinking.

**Masking during activity:** students and chaperones are expected to follow district masking protocols regardless of the procedures in the field trip venue. Students and chaperones are expected to wear masks over their nose and mouth while indoors at all times.
