•The District has five series of outstanding issuances of adjustable interest rate certificates of participation ("COPs") issued between 2003 and 2006. Annual debt service payments on these COPs were originally intended to be paid from a combination of CFD special tax proceeds and developer fees. On November 20,

2007, a presentation was given to the Board reviewing each of the outstanding COPs and their scheduled repayment structures, along with the availability and timing of the revenue sources. Potential debt restructuring options were presented to the Board for discussion and/or direction.
